PRELIMINARY MATTERS

US West Communications ("US West"), of Omaha, Nebraska filed an application to revise the boundary between its Fremont exchange and the Colon exchange served by Aliant Communications ("Aliant"), on September 25, 1996. Specifically, the applicant requests a boundary change be made so as to allow Mr. Dave Hilgenkamp, Les Hilgenkamp, and Carl Johnson, all current customers of Aliant to receive service from US West. Notice of the application was published in the Omaha Daily Record on September 26, 1996 pursuant to the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

BY THE COMMISSION

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Aliant and US West are local exchange carriers operating in Nebraska and are subject to the Commission's general regulation of common carriers. This application is governed specifically by Neb. Rev. Stats. Sec. 75-604 to 75-616 (1994 Cum. Supp.). These statutes establish that if the telephone company or companies affected by the proposed boundary revisions do not object to the application, the application may be processed by modified procedure. In this case, no protests were received; therefore, the Commission will proceed pursuant to its Rule of Modified Procedure.

Attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is a map of that portion of the boundary lying between the US West's Fremont exchange and Aliant's Colon exchange showing the proposed boundary line which will be effective should this application be granted.

Attached hereto marked Exhibit "B" and incorporated by this reference is a letter from Aliant wherein said company consents to the revision of the exchange boundary and its willingness to relinquish said area to permit the applicant to furnish telephone service to Mr. Dave Hilgenkamp, Les Hilgenkamp, and Carl Johnson.
