By application filed November 1, 1996, American Business Alliance, Inc. of Kingston, Pennsylvania, seeks authority to register an additional trade name, "Commercial Phone Group". Notice of the application was published in the Omaha Daily Record, November 5, 1996 in accordance with the Commission's Rules of Procedure. No protests to the application were filed. Therefore, this application was reviewed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure (see Title 291, NAC Ch. 1, Rule 018.03).

O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

American Business Alliance, Inc. (ABA) was issued and continues to operate pursuant to a certificate of public convenience and necessity that was granted by the Commission in Application C-1356 on October 8, 1996.

ABA seeks authorization to do business under the additional registered trade name, "Commercial Phone Group". That name would be used in marketing telecommunications services to potential commercial customers. All customers to whom ABA markets service under this new trade name and who subscribe to the service will receive bills under the Commercial Phone Group name in order to avoid any customer confusion.

Based on the evidence supplied in the application, the request should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-1434 be, and it is hereby granted and American Business Alliance, Inc., is authorized to register the additional trade name of Commercial Phone Group.
