O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

On March 17, 1997, pursuant to Application No. C-1457, Discount Network Services, Inc. (DNS) of Dearborn, Michigan, was granted authority to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska.

On March 22, 2001, the Commission received a letter from DNS informing the Commission of its desire to withdraw its certificate of operating authority. DNS is not currently conducting business in Nebraska, thus no customer notice is required. The Commission is of the opinion that DNS's request should be honored and its certificate should be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the certificate of operating authority previously issued in Application No. C-1457 to Discount Network Services, Inc. be, and it is hereby, canceled.
