## NUNC PRO TUNCO PINION AND FINDINGS

On December 18, 1996, an application was filed by Pierce Telephone Company, Inc. (Pierce Telephone) and Pierce Telecommunications, Inc. (PTI) both of Pierce, Nebraska seeking approval of the transfer of control and assets of Pierce Telephone to PTI. Notice of the application was published in the The Daily Record on December 19, 1996. No protests were filed; therefore, this application has been administered pursuant to the Commission's modified procedure rule.

Pierce Telephone obtained a certificate of public convenience and necessity from the Commission by virtue of the laws of the State of Nebraska and offers local exchange service in Pierce, Stanton and Wayne Counties.

The shareholders of Pierce Telephone propose to transfer all of their shares of Pierce Telephone to PTI in an exchange of common stock of PTI on a share-for-share basis. The shareholders, officers and directors of PTI will be identical to the shareholders, officers and directors of Pierce Telephone. No changes will be made in the manner or method of operation.

This order is being entered to clarify that the certificate of authority will not be transferred to PTI upon completion of the proposed transaction. Pierce Telephone will remain the certificated carrier operating within Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the requirements of Commission rule 002.26A have been satisfied. The transfer of control of Pierce Telephone to PTI should be granted as clarified above.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application C-1462 be, and it is hereby, granted.
