BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 20, 1997, Aliant Cellular, Inc. (Aliant), Omaha Cellular Limited Partnership (Omaha Cellular), and US West Communications, Inc. (USW) jointly filed an application seeking approval of their voluntarily negotiated interconnection agreement. The Commission approved the request on June 23, 1997.

On December 22, 1997, USW and Aliant jointly requested to amend their existing interconnection agreement to lower certain nonrecurring trunk routing change charges.

The Telecommunications Act of 1996 requires state commissions to approve all interconnection agreements. We have reviewed the proposed amendment to the interconnection agreement between USW and Aliant and find it to be reasonable. It should be approved with an effective date of January 2, 1998, pursuant to Commission policy.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that effective January 2, 1998, the interconnection agreement between US West Communications and Aliant Cellular, Inc. is hereby amended as reflected on the two-page attachment that is made a part of this order.
