O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

By application filed April 16, 1997, Phonetime, Inc., of Whitestone, New York, seeks authority to provide intraLATA and interLATA telecommunications services in Nebraska. Notice of the application appeared in the The Daily Record, April 18, 1997. No protests were filed; therefore, we will process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Phonetime, Inc. was incorporated April 21, 1995 in New York. The applicant has received authority to operate in approximately twelve states and plans to become certified in all fifty (50) states. No state has denied Phonetime a certificate of authority.

The underlying carriers for the services will be Allnet, Sprint, and LDDS. The company's name and customer service number are located on all its bills. In addition, Phonetime has a toll-free 800 number for customer service, which operates seven days a week, twenty-four hours a day.

Phonetime, Inc. plans to offer outbound and inbound long distance services, calling card services, debit card services and directory assistance services statewide to both residential and business customers. With the exception of debit card services, Phonetime will operate as a switchless reseller.

From examination of the application filed herein, the Commission finds the applicant has provided all the information required by the Commission, possesses adequate financial resources to provide the proposed service and possesses adequate technical competency to provide the proposed service. The application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-1527 be, and it is hereby, granted and Phonetime, Inc. is hereby authorized to operate as

a resale carrier of intrastate interexchange intraLATA and interLATA telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant shall file, in accordance with the applicable statutes on or before April 30th of each year, an annual report with this Commission consisting of (a) a copy of any report filed with the Federal Communications Commission, (b) a copy of any annual report to stockholders, (c) a copy of the latest Form 10-K filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission, (d) balance sheet and income statement for the previous year of operation and (e) for the State of Nebraska on a combined interstate-intrastate basis, the investment in telephone plant and equipment located within the state, accumulated depreciation thereon, operating revenues, operating expenses, and taxes.



IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file an updated tariff prior to offering service pursuant to the certificate granted in this order.


