O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

By application filed April 17, 1997, Association Admini-  
strators, Inc., of Smithtown, New York, seeks authority to pro-  
vide intraLATA and interLATA resold telecommunications services  
within the state of Nebraska. Notice of the application was pub-  
lished in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 18, 1997,  
pursuant to the rules of the Commission. No protests were  
filed. Hearing on the application was held by video communica-  
tion on August 12, 1997.

Applicant produced one witness, Kevin Klepper, who tes-  
tified: He is president and a director of applicant. More than  
40 states have authorized applicant to operate within their  
states. No complaints are pending against applicant in any of  
them. Applicant offers 1+ long distance, 800 service and cal-  
ling cards. It markets its services among physicians, lawyers  
and pilots using telemarketing and mailers, which include a \$50  
check to a potential subscriber who obtains service by endorsing  
the check (Exhibit #4). Applicant does its own billing but re-  
lies on Sprint for technical expertise. Current financial re-  
cords show applicant has been profitable since March 31, 1997.

Interexchange reseller applications are subject to  
Commission jurisdiction under Neb. Rev. Stat. Sections 75-604  
and 86-805 and Title 291 of the Commission's Rules and Regula-  
tions, Chapter 5, Rule 003.12. From examination of the appli-  
cation filed herein and the testimony adduced at the hearing,  
the Commission finds applicant has provided all the information  
required by the Commission, possesses adequate financial re-  
sources to provide the proposed service, and possesses adequate  
technical competency to provide the proposed service. The  
application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application Number C-1528 be, and it is hereby, granted and Association Administrators, Inc., Smithtown, New York, is hereby authorized to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate interexchange intraLATA and interLATA telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant shall file, in accordance with the applicable statutes on or before April 30th of each year, an annual report with this Commission consisting of (a) a copy of any report filed with the Federal Communications Commission, (b) a copy of any annual report to stockholders, (c) a copy of the latest Form 10-K filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission, (d) a balance sheet and income statement for the previous year of operation and (e) for the State of Nebraska on a combined interstate-intrastate basis, the investment in telephone plant and equipment located within the state, accumulated depreciation thereon, operating revenues, operating expenses, and taxes.



IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file its current tariff within thirty days.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby made, the Commission's official certificate of authority to furnish the service authorized herein as a common carrier.
