## BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed May 23, 1997, Citizens Telecommunications Company, d/b/a Citizens Telecom, of Stamford Connecticut seeks approval to change its name to Citizens Communications Company. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, May 27, 1997. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure (see Title 291, NAC Ch. 1, Rule 018.03).

## OPINION AND FINDINGS

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

Citizens was granted authority to provide intrastate inter-LATA and intraLATA interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska pursuant to C-1289 on April 6, 1996. Since certification, no formal complaints have been filed against the company.

The proposed name change will not noticeably impact customers in Nebraska and will not affect the company's management, ownership, quality of service or rates. Furthermore, the change is relatively minor, simply changing the name Citizens Telecommunications Company, d/b/a Citizens Telecom to the name Citizens Communications Company.

Based on the contents of the application, the request is reasonable, is in the public interest, and should be granted.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-1548 be, and it is hereby granted and the name Citizens Telecommunications Company, d/b/a Citizens Telecom is changed to Citizens Communications Company.
