BY THE COMMISSION:

On June 19, 1997, an application was filed by Parcel Consultants, Inc. (Parcel) of Bloomfield, New Jersey, seeking authority to reorganize its corporate structure. On August 6, 1997, Parcel filed an amendment to its application requesting authority to do business as Minimum Rate Pricing, Inc. and MRP. Notice of the initial application was published in The Daily Record, June 24, 1997. Notice of the amended application was published August 8, 1997. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Parcel received a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide intrastate telecommunications services on October 22, 1996, in Application C-1394. Currently, no formal or departmental complaints are pending against Parcel.

Parcel requests its ownership be transferred to National TeleCommunications, Inc. (National), a newly formed corporation. Parcel would then become a wholly-owned subsidiary of National. The shareholders of Parcel have exchanged their shares for new shares of National. The transfer of ownership will not effect management, rates or quality. All services will continue to be provided through Parcel.

The application also requests authority for Parcel to do business as Minimum Rate Pricing, Inc. and MRP. All rates, terms and conditions of the current tariff will remain unchanged if this application is approved.

Upon consideration of the application, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application C-1565 be, and it is hereby, granted.
