## BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 1, 1997, Sprint Spectrum L.P. (Sprint) and US West Communications, Inc. (USW) jointly filed an application seeking approval of their voluntarily negotiated interconnection agreement. The Commission approved the request on August 5, 1997.

On June 19, 1998, USW and Sprint jointly requested to amend their existing interconnection agreement to lower the charges for certain nonrecurring trunk routing changes from that of charging on a per trunk basis to charging on a per trunk group basis.

The Telecommunications Act of 1996 requires state commissions to approve all interconnection agreements. We have reviewed the proposed amendment to the interconnection agreement between USW and Sprint and find it to be reasonable. It should be approved with an effective date of June 29, 1998, pursuant to Commission policy.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that effective June 29, 1998, the interconnection agreement between US West Communications, Inc. and Sprint Spectrum L.P. is hereby amended as reflected on the two-page attachment that is made a part of this order.
