On July 30, 1997, an application was filed by LDC Telecommunications, Inc. (LDC) of Oldsmar, Florida, seeking authority to market certain service offerings or products doing business as OmniTel Communications and/or UniTel Communications. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, August 1, 1997. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

LDC received a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide intrastate telecommunications services on January 9, 1996, in Application C-1243. Currently, no formal or departmental complaints are pending against LDC.

The application requests authority for LDC to market certain service offerings or products as OmniTel Communications and/or UniTel Communications. The names will be used for marketing purposes in order to increase market share. All rates, terms and conditions of the current tariff will remain unchanged.

Upon consideration of the application, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the application should be granted.
