O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On October 21, 1997, pursuant to Application No. C-1599, KCI Long Distance, Inc. (KCI) of East Syracuse, New York, was granted authority to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate interLATA and intraLATA interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska.

On March 3, 2000, the Commission received a letter from KCI requesting that its certificate of operating authority be withdrawn. KCI has never provided service in Nebraska; therefore, no customers will be inconvenienced by the cancellation of KCI's certificate. The Commission is of the opinion that KCI's request should be honored and its certificate should be canceled.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the certificate of operating authority previously issued in Application No. C-1599 to KCI Long Distance, Inc. be, and it is hereby, canceled.
