BY THE COMMISSION

On August 6, 1997, an application was filed by Zenex Long Distance, Inc. (Zenex) of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, ACG Acquisition VI Corp. (ACG) and Advanced Communications Group, Inc. (Advanced), both of Houston Texas. The applicants seek approval of an agreement and plan of merger. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, August 7, 1997. No protests were filed, therefore the Commission approved the application via modified procedure on September 9, 1997. On September 17, 1997, the applicants filed a motion to reconsider the Commission's September 9, 1997 Order, as the anticipated merger was not going to take place as planned. Upon reviewing the motion, we find it should be granted. The Order previously entered herein is to be considered null and void.
