BY THE COMMISSION:

On August 12, 1997, this docket was opened to designate telecommunications carriers eligible to receive universal service
support and to define the service areas for which carriers shall
receive support pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission
(FCC) Order, Common Carrier Docket CC-96-45. Initial comments were
to be submitted on this issue by September 12, 1997. Reply comments were due on or before September 30, 1997. On October 15,
1997, an Order was entered designating both rural and non-rural
Eligible Telecommunications Carriers (ETCs) for Nebraska. We also
defined in that Order the service areas for ETCs. However, it has
come to our attention that the definition of rural service areas
was unclear. Therefore, we enter this Order to clarify the proper
service area for rural ETCs.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

As stated in our previous Order, we find a rural carrier's study area should be its service area. However, we agree with many commenters that a carrier's study area should generally be contiguous. In the future, if a rural ETC serves a non-contiguous study area, the carrier should have multiple contiguous study areas. This designation better targets where high cost support is needed and does not pose a barrier to competitive entry. However, at this time, it is more appropriate to designate a carrier's study area as its service area.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the designated study areas for rural carriers be, and hereby are its service area.
