## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On August 12, 1997, US West NewVector Group, Inc. of Washington, on behalf of itself and Omaha Cellular Telephone Company dba AirTouch Cellular, filed an application requesting authority to invoke Section 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act) to utilize the arbitrated agreement between US West Communications, Inc. (US West) and Western Wireless Corporation (Western Wireless). Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record on August 13, 1997. The Nebraska Independent Telephone Association filed comments on the application. No protests were filed; therefore, this application has been administered pursuant to the Commission's modified procedure rule.

AirTouch Cellular is a wireless provider offering cellular telecommunications services within Section 252(i) of the Act allows any telecommunications company to adopt a Commission approved interconnection AirTouch Cellular wishes to agreement. establish interconnection agreement with US West and accordingly, seeks to adopt the US West/Western Wireless interconnection The US West/Western Wireless agreement was agreement. approved by the Commission pursuant to Application C-1409 and became effective April 8, 1997.

On May 28, 1997, the Commission added language to its mediation/arbitration policy (see Application No. C-1128, Progression Order No. 3) which sets forth the procedures to followed for a Section 252(i) request. AirTouch Cellular has followed the procedures required by the Commission's policy.
