By application filed September 9, 1997, Family Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a FTI Communications (FTI) of Phoenix, Arizona seeks authority to change its name to I-Link Communications, Inc. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, September 11, 1997. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

FTI received a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide intrastate telecommunications services on May 6, 1997, pursuant to Application C-1463. Currently, no formal or departmental complaints are pending against FTI.

The application requests authority for FTI to change its name to I-Link Communications, Inc. I-Link Communications, Inc. will also do business under the names FTI Communications and Family Telecommunications. FTI has filed the requisite forms with the Nebraska Secretary of State to change its name in Nebraska.

No rates, terms or conditions will change as a result of the change in name. Bills will continue to be rendered directly by the company under the names FTI Communications, Family Telecommunications or I-Link Communications.

Upon consideration of the application, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the application should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application C-1621 be, and it is hereby granted.


