O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On October 21, 1997, pursuant to Application No. C-1622, Efficy Group, Inc. (EGI) of Greenville, South Carolina, was granted authority to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska.

On December 19, 2000, the Commission received a letter from EGI informing the Commission that due to a recent purchase of EGI's assets by Access Point, Inc., EGI is no longer conducting business as a telecommunications company in Nebraska and no longer has any customers within the state. Accordingly, EGI requests that their certificate of operating authority be canceled. The Commission is of the opinion that EGI's request should be honored and its certificate should be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the certificate of operating authority previously issued to in Application No. C-1622 to Efficy Group, Inc. be, and it is hereby, canceled.
