O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On April 11, 1997, the Commission entered an order in this docket instituting an investigation into the structure of intrastate access charges. Included in this investigation is the issue of regulating Internet service provider (ISP) traffic.

On December 15, 1998, the Commission entered an order in Docket No. C-1960 instituting an investigation into the characterization and treatment of ISP traffic for purposes of payment of reciprocal compensation.

Due to the existence of a docket dealing with issues under investigation in this docket, and compelled by the goal of administrative efficiency, the Commission is of the opinion that all issues presented in this docket concerning ISP regulation and the like should be transferred from this docket for consideration within Docket No. C-1960.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that all issues presented in this docket relating to the regulation of Internet service providers be, and they are hereby, removed for consideration within Docket No. C-1960.
