OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed September 23, 1997, United Services Telephone, LLC, ("UST" or "Applicant") of Nashville, Tennessee, seeks authority to provide intraLATA and interLATA interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska. Notice of the application appeared in The Daily Record on September 24, 1997. No protests were filed; therefore, this application was administered pursuant to the Commission's Rules of Modified Procedure.

UST was organized as a limited liability company under the laws of the state of Tennessee on July 18, 1996. It received a Certificate of Authority to transact business in the state of Nebraska as a foreign limited liability company on June 3, 1997. Applicant currently has authority to provide services in 8 states, and has filed for and plans to become certificated in the remaining 42 states. No state has denied applicant a certificate of authority.

UST's communications network in Nebraska will utilize the telecommunications facilities of BNI and other carriers certificated with the Commission. The company's name and customer service number are printed on all its bills. In addition, applicant has a toll-free 800 number for customer service.

Applicant will offer 1+ interexchange telecommunications, 800 services, WATS and travel card services statewide to both residential and business customers.

Due to the time frame of incorporation, annual financial statements for the previous three years of operations were not available. Financial statements submitted by the applicant for the Application No. C-1638

most recent interim period ending July 31, 1997, indicate that profitability has been achieved.

Interexchange reseller applications are subject to Commission jurisdiction under Neb. Rev. Stat. Sections 75-604 and 86-805 and Title 291 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5, Rule 003.12. From examination of the application filed herein, the Commission finds: 1) Applicant has provided all the information required by the Commission; 2) Applicant has adequate financial resources to provide the proposed service; 3) Applicant possesses adequate technical competency to provide the proposed service; and 4) The application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-1638 be, and it is hereby, granted and United Services Telephone, LLC, is hereby authorized to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate interexchange intraLATA and interLATA telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant shall file, in accordance with the applicable statutes on or before April 30th of each year, an annual report with this Commission consisting of (a) a copy of any report filed with the Federal Communications Commission, (b) a copy of any annual report to stockholders and (c) a copy of the latest Form 10-K filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission. If applicant is unable to file items (a), (b) and (c), it shall submit a copy of its balance sheet and income statement for the previous year of operation, and schedules showing telephone plant and equipment located within the state, accumulated depreciation thereon, operating revenues, operating expenses, and taxes applicable to Nebraska operations or a statement that no operations were conducted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file a tariff within thirty days.
