O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On November 18, 1997, pursuant to Application No. C-1641, Quintelco, Inc. (Quintelco) of Pearl River, New York, was granted authority to operate as a resale carrier of interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska.

On April 6, 2001, the Commission was notified of Quintelco's request to have its certificate canceled. Quintelco states that it is not providing services in Nebraska and has no future plans to provide service, and therefore requests that its certificate be revoked. The Commission finds that Quintelco's request should be honored and Quintelco's certificate should be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Certificate Public Convenience and Necessity previously issued in Application No. C-1641 to Quintelco, Inc. be, and it is hereby, canceled.
