BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 8, 1997, an application was filed by Qwest Communications Corp. (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, seeking approval to provide certain telecommunications services under the name QNC. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, December 11, 1997. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Southern Pacific Telecommunications Company was authorized to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services on December 20, 1994, pursuant to Application No. C-1121. The certificate was subsequently amended to reflect a change in name to Qwest Communications Corp. on July 31, 1995, in Application C-1206.

Applicant requests authority to use the trade name QNC to provide a certain interexchange service to residential customers. This service will be marketed, billed and provided by Qwest under the name QNC. Customers may also obtain a calling card from Qwest under the name QNC. Applicant has obtained authority from the Nebraska Secretary of State to utilize the name QNC in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-1705 be, and it is hereby, granted and Qwest Communications Corp. is hereby authorized to provide certain services under the trade name QNC.


