O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

International Charity Network, Inc. was authorized to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services on September 20, 1997, pursuant to Application No. C-1547. No formal or departmental complaints are pending against the applicant.

For business reasons, applicant requests authority to change its name to Charities Network International, Inc. Applicant has obtained authority from the Nebraska Secretary of State to utilize the name Charities Network International in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the application should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-1716 be, and it is hereby, granted and International Charity Network, Inc. is hereby authorized to change the name on its operating authority to Charities Network International, Inc.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the amendment authorized herein within thirty days from the date of this order.
