OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed January 7, 1998, National Collegiate, Inc. (National Collegiate) of Bloomington, Indiana, was granted authority to provide intraLATA and interLATA resold interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska on March 10, 1998.

National Collegiate was originally incorporated under the name Pegasus Information Systems, Inc. (Pegasus) under the laws of the State of Indiana on October 3, 1988.

In March, 1998, Pegasus changed its name to National Collegiate Inc. Upon review, the National Collegiate application was simply a request for a change in name from Pegasus Information Systems, Inc. to National Collegiate, Inc.

As such, the order entered granting National Collegiate a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should have also simultaneously revoked the authorization previously granted to Pegasus.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued to Pegasus Information Systems, Inc. be, and it is hereby, revoked.
