OPINION AND FINDINGS

On March 10, 1998, pursuant to Application No. C-1750, Facilicom International, LLC (FaciliCom or Applicant), of Washington, DC, was granted authority to provide intraLATA and interLATA resold interexchange telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska.

On April 12, 2000, the Commission received a letter from FaciliCom requesting that its certificate of operating authority be canceled. Applicant has never provided service within the state of Nebraska; therefore, no customers will be inconvenienced by the cancellation of FaciliCom's certificate. The Commission finds that the applicant's certificate and tariff should be canceled.
