BY THE COMMISSION:

On February 17, 1998, NebCom, Inc. of Jackson, Nebraska, filed an application to revise the boundary between its Long Pine exchange and the Ainsworth exchange served by US West Communications (US West). Notice of the application was published in the The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 18, 1998, pursuant to the Commission's Rules.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

NebCom and US West are local exchange carriers operating in Nebraska and are subject to the Commission's general regulation of common carriers. Nebraska statutes establish if the telephone company or companies affected by proposed boundary revisions do not object to the application, the application may be processed by modified procedure. By letter dated January 9, 1998, US West informed NebCom it concurred with its proposed boundary change. A copy of said letter was included with the application. Since no protests were filed, the Commission will process the application pursuant to its rule of modified procedure.

The applicant attached a map showing the proposed placement of the boundary between the Long Pine and Ainsworth exchanges. The boundary change is being requested for the purpose of serving Mr. Jim Bayer. Mr. Bayer is building a new residence in the Ainsworth exchange on previously undeveloped land.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the application should be granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that NebCom, Inc. and US West Communications submit revised boundary maps to the Commission within 30 days from the date of this order.



