BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 2, 1998, Clarity Telecom LD Network Services, Inc. ("Clarity" or "Applicant") of Milford, Connecticut, filed an application seeking a name change and corresponding amendments to its tariff. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 19, 1998. No protests were filed. Therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Clarity received a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a reseller of interLATA and intra-LATA telecommunications services September 3, 1997, in Application No. C-1511. Currently, no formal or departmental complaints are pending against Applicant.

Applicant is requesting authority to change its name to Claricom Networks, Inc. effective February 1, 1998. On December 15, 1997, it filed an application for a legal corporate name change in Delaware, its state of incorporation. Applicant has also filed an application with the Nebraska Secretary of State for a name change in its Certificate to Transact Business. Further, Applicant notified its customers of the name change in a December 15, 1997, bill insert.

Upon consideration of the application, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted with an effective date of February 1, 1998.
