## BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 23, 1998, UniDial, Incorporated (UniDial) and UniDial Holdings, Inc. (UD Holdings) of Louisville, Kentucky, filed an application seeking Commission approval of an internal corporate organization and name change affecting UniDial. Notice of the application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 24, 1998. No protests were filed. Therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On December 13, 1993, in Application No. C-1022, the Commission granted authority to UniDial to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska. No formal or departmental complaints are pending against applicant.

Applicant requests that the Commission approve its change in name and corporate reorganization. UniDial seeks to change its name to UniDial Communications, Inc. (UD Communications). UD Communications will then become a wholly-owned subsidiary to the newly created UD Holdings. UD Holdings will be owned by the present owners of UniDial in proportions identical to their current interests in UniDial. Following this reorganization, UD Holdings will hold 100 percent of the stock of UD Communications. The transaction will not affect the ultimate ownership or control of UD Communications. Further, there will not be any change in corporate officers, directors, or pricing of services as a result of the reorganization. Consequently, this series of transactions constitutes a proforma reorganization and will be virtually transparent to the company's customers.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the application should be granted.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-1781 be, and it is hereby, granted retroactively to April 20, 1998.
