BY THE COMMISSION:

Diller Telephone Company (Diller) of Diller, Nebraska, filed an application to revise the boundary of its Harbine exchange on March 24, 1998. Specifically, Diller requests a boundary change be made so as to allow Alan Thober and Dana Schleufer (customers) to receive service from Diller in the Harbine exchange. Customers currently subscribe to Aliant Communications (Aliant) in the Beatrice exchange. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record on March 26, 1998, pursuant to the Commission's Rules.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Diller and Aliant are local exchange carriers operating in Nebraska and are subject to the Commission's general regulation of common carriers. This application is governed by Neb. Rev. Stat. Sections 75-612 and 75-613 (Reissue 1996). These statutes provide that if the telephone companies affected by the proposed boundary revisions do not object to the application, the application may be processed by modified procedure. In this case, no protests were filed. Therefore, this application has been administered pursuant to the Commission's modified procedure rule.

The applicant submitted a map showing the proposed revision of the Harbine and Beatrice boundaries. Aliant consented to the revision of the exchange boundary and has expressed its willingness to relinquish said area to permit Diller to furnish service to customers.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the statutory requirements have been met.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-1783 be, and it is hereby, granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Diller Telephone Company and Aliant Communications file revised boundary maps within 30 days from the date of this order.


