On May 27, 1998, pursuant to Application No. C-1795, EQuality, Inc. (EQuality) of Wallingford, Connecticut, was granted authority to operate as a resale carrier of interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska.

EQuality, in a letter dated March 1, 2001, has notified the Commission that EQuality, Inc. has ceased all business activity, as of January 1, 2001, and requests termination of its Nebraska authority. In light of this fact, the Commission is of the opinion that EQuality's certificate should be canceled.




O R D E R
