On April 17, 1998, an application was filed by NeTeL Inc. of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, seeking authority to use the trade name TEL3 in Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in <u>The Daily Record</u>, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 21, 1998. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Applicant received authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services from this Commission on October 31, 1995, pursuant to Application No. C-1173. No formal or departmental complaints are pending against applicant.

Applicant requests authority to use the trade name TEL3 in Nebraska. Customers of the company were advised of this change in the monthly newsletter, which is sent to all existing customers. The company's managerial, technical, and financial capabilities will not change. A revised tariff is being prepared to reflect the company's new trade name. Applicant has obtained authority from the Nebraska Secretary of State to utilize the trade name TEL3 in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-1798 be, and it is hereby, granted and NeTeL Inc. is hereby authorized to use the trade name TEL3 in Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within thirty days from the date of this order.
