BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed April 28, 1998, Comcast Telecommunications, Inc., dba Comcast Long Distance, King of Prussia, Pennsylvania, (Applicant) seeks authority to provide intraLATA and interLATA resold interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska. Notice of the application appeared in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 29, 1998. No protests were filed; therefore, this application was administered pursuant to the Commission's Rules of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Applicant is a privately-held corporation organized under the laws of the state of Pennsylvania on July 20, 1993. In October 1997, a transfer of control to Comcast Telephony Communications, Inc., a Delaware corporation, was effected through the sale of Applicant's stock. On November 24, 1997, Applicant changed its name to Comcast Telecommunications, Inc. from Globalcom Telecommunications Inc. Applicant has received authorization from the Nebraska Secretary of State to conduct business in Nebraska under the changed name. Applicant plans to offer 1+, 800/888 and travel card services on a resale basis throughout Nebraska. Applicant filed evidence demonstrating its technical and financial competency.

Interexchange reseller applications are subject to Commission jurisdiction under Neb. Rev. Stat. Sections 75-604 and 86-805 and Title 291 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5, Rule 003.12. From examination of the application filed herein, the Commission finds: 1) Applicant has provided all the information required by the Commission; 2) Applicant has adequate financial resources to provide the proposed service; 3) Applicant possesses

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adequate technical competency to provide the proposed service; and 4) The application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-1805 be, and it is hereby, granted and Comcast Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a/ Comcast Long Distance is hereby authorized to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate interexchange intraLATA and interLATA telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant shall file, in accordance with the applicable statutes on or before April 30th of each year, an annual report with this Commission consisting of (a) a copy of any report filed with the Federal Communications Commission, (b) a copy of any annual report to stockholders and, (c) a copy of the latest Form 10-K filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission. If applicant is unable to file items (a), (b) and (c), it shall submit a copy of its balance sheet and income statement for the previous year of operation and schedules showing telephone plant and equipment located within the state, accumulated depreciation thereon, operating revenues, operating expenses, and taxes applicable to Nebraska operations or a statement that no operations were conducted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file its current tariff prior to offering service pursuant to the certificate granted in this order.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby made, the Commission's official certificate of authority to furnish the service authorized herein as a common carrier.
