BY THE COMMISSION:

On June 16, 1998, pursuant to Application No. C-1806, Long Distance International, Inc. (LDI) of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, was granted authority to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate interLATA and intraLATA telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska.

On March 20, 2000, the Commission received a letter from LDI requesting the Commission to cancel its authority to operate in the state of Nebraska. Prior to commencing business in Nebraska, LDI limited its scope of operations. LDI did not provision nor invoice any customers within the state of Nebraska. LDI does not intend to operate in Nebraska in the future. Therefore, the Commission is of the opinion that LDI's request should be honored and its certificate and tariff should be canceled.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the tariff filed with the Commission and the certificate of operating authority previously issued in Application No. C-1806, to Long Distance International, Inc. be, and is hereby, canceled.
