On June 16, 1998, the Commission, by its own motion, opened a docket, whereby it sought an investigation into Internet Telephony (IT). The purpose of this docket was to define what IT is, to determine what regulatory or oversight role the Commission has in relation to IT, to determine what responsibility internet service providers have to Nebraska customers, and examine the place of IT in the telecommunications industry. The purpose of this docket has not changed. However, the date by which the Commission requested that all interested persons submit comments and recommendations on issues raised in this docket has changed to August 28, 1998.
