## OPINION AND FINDINGS

By motion filed November 30, 2001, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) seeks a continuance of the Performance Data and Data Reconciliation hearing (PID hearing) scheduled for December 10-11, 2001, pursuant to the Nebraska Public Service Commission's Procedural Order No. 23. In support of its motion, Qwest stated that it was not clear if the Arizona data reconciliation report would be used for all states and reconciliation of the Nebraska specific data would not be completed until the end of December 2001. Therefore, Qwest requested that a continuance of the PID hearing until January 7, 2002, may be necessary in order to allow presentation at the hearing of the Liberty data reconciliation along with Qwest's performance data.

Upon consideration of Qwest's motion for continuance and arguments therein, the Commission is of the opinion and finds said motion to be fair and reasonable. Qwest's motion should be granted. Accordingly, the Commission modifies the previously set procedural schedule as follows:
