BY THE COMMISSION:

On June 23, 1998, US West Communications (US West) filed an application requesting that the Nebraska Public Service Commission verify its compliance with Section 271(c) of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. The Commission held a hearing on such application on November 16-20, 1998.

On January 25, 1999, The United States Supreme Court issued its opinion in AT&T Corp., et. al. vs. Iowa Utilities Board et. al. In so doing, the Court overturned the 8th Circuit Court of Appeals on several telecommunications issues.

In light of this ruling:

1. All interested parties may file briefs with the Commission by 5:00 C.S.T. February 16, 1999, detailing the effect of the Supreme Court's decision on Application No. C-1830.
2. Each party filing a brief with the Commission shall also serve a copy of such brief upon all other parties to the Application by 5:00 C.S.T. February 16, 1999.
3. Each party submitting a brief may also file a Reply Brief with the Commission by 5:00 C.S.T. February 23, 1999.
4. Parties submitting Briefs and Reply Briefs should file three paper copies and one electronic copy in WordPerfect 5.0 format or newer.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that all parties to Application No. C-1830 may file Briefs and Reply Briefs detailing the effect of the U.S. Supreme Court's decision in AT&T Corp., et. al. vs. Iowa Utilities Board et. al. upon Application No. C-1830.


