O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

Upon further review and in consideration of additional delays in release times for the Antonuk reports, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the procedural schedule issued on June 27, 2001, should once again be modified. In an effort to avoid unnecessary confusion, the updated timeline for Application Nos. C-1830 and C-2537 is set forth in its entirety below:

August 8	Prefiled testimony for PIDS data and any remaining checklist items is due.
August 20	Deadline for intervenors' submission of any additional impasse issues that relate to the <i>Seven State Collaborative Group #4 Report</i> .
August 22	Hearing on PIDS data and any remaining checklist items begins at 10:00 a.m.
August 27	Deadline for briefing impasse issues related to <i>Seven State Collaborative Group #4 Report</i> .
September 5	Oral Argument on <i>Seven State Collaborative Group #4 Report</i> .
September 12	Deadline for intervenors' submission of any additional impasse issues that relate to the <i>Seven State Collaborative Group #5 Report</i> .
September 24	Deadline for briefing impasse issues related to the <i>Seven State Collaborative Group #5 Report</i> .
October 3, 4, 5	(The oral arguments will begin at 10:00 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Room.)


