BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed August 5, 1998, Network International, LC (Applicant) of Gaithersburg, Maryland, seeks authority to provide intraLATA and interLATA resold interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska. Notice of the application appeared in The Daily Record on August 6, 1998. No protests were filed; therefore, this application was administered pursuant to the Commission's Rules of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Applicant is a privately-held corporation organized under the laws of the state of Virginia on April 30, 1996. Applicant has received authorization from the Nebraska Secretary of State to conduct business in Nebraska. Applicant plans to offer 1+, 800/888, and calling card services on a resale basis throughout Nebraska. Applicant filed evidence demonstrating its technical and financial competency.

Interexchange reseller applications are subject to Commission jurisdiction under Neb. Rev. Stat. Sections 75-604 and 86-805 and Title 291 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5, Rule 003.12. From examination of the application filed herein, the Commission finds: 1) Applicant has provided all the information required by the Commission; 2) Applicant has adequate financial resources to provide the proposed service; 3) Applicant possesses adequate technical competency to provide the proposed service; and 4) The application should be granted.
