## BY THE COMMISSION:

On the motion filed by complainant in this matter on September 10, 1998, the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) finds and orders as follows.

## OPINION AND FINDINGS

Complainant, John Burvainis, presented preliminary evidence of numerous complaints dealing with USA Tele Corp., of Pompano, Florida, regarding the defendant's marketing practices and misrepresentations. Specifically, complainant alleged:

- 1. Complainant is Deputy Director of the Department of Communications of this Commission.
- On December 23, 1997, defendant obtained a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a resale common carrier of telecommunications services in Nebraska in Application No. C-1578.
- The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter because defendant provides intrastate telecommunications services in Nebraska.
- 4. The Commission finds the defendant's marketing practices highly suspect.
- 5. The Commission has received numerous complaints from customers about the defendant's marketing practices and misrepresentations.
- 6. Defendant's suspect marketing practices and misrepresentations are not in the public's interest.
- 7. Staff has been unable to obtain information as to the status of defendant's marketing practices and the reasons for the defendant's misrepresentations.
