BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 3, 1998, Frontier Local Services, Inc. (Frontier) and US West Communications, Inc. (US West) jointly filed an application seeking approval of their voluntarily-negotiated interconnection agreement. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record on September 9, 1998. The Nebraska Independent Telephone Association filed comments on Frontier Telecommunications and US West's interconnection agreement. No protests were filed.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

By letter dated November 3, 1998, Frontier and US West jointly seek to withdraw Application C-1901. Attached to the letter was an agreement between Frontier and US West to cancel and withdraw the June 15, 1998, interconnection agreement between the two parties. That agreement was the subject of Application No. C-1901. Another agreement between Frontier Telemanagement, Inc. and US West was adopted pursuant to Section 252(i) of the Federal Communications Act and was approved by this Commission on October 20, 1998, in Application No. C-1912.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the application should be withdrawn.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the voluntarily-negotiated interconnection agreement between Frontier Local Services, Inc. and US West Communications, Inc. be, and it is hereby, withdrawn.
