O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

On November 24, 1998, pursuant to Application No. C-1908, Megsinet-CLEC, Inc. (M-CLEC) of Chicago, Illinois, was granted authority to operate as a resale carrier of interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska.

M-CLEC, in a letter dated September 7, 2000, requests that their certificate be canceled. M-CLEC has never provided service in Nebraska and has never had any customers within the state, therefore, no Nebraska consumers will be impacted by the cancellation of M-CLEC's certificate. The Commission is of the opinion that M-CLEC's request should be honored and its certificate should be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the certificate of operating authority previously issued in Application No. C-1908 to Megsinet-CLEC, Inc., be, and it is hereby, canceled.
