## BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 6, 1998, Century Telecommunications, Inc. (Applicant) filed an application seeking authority to change its corporate name to CenturyTel Telecommunications, Inc. Notice of the application was published in <a href="https://doi.org/10.1001/journal.org/">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 8, 1998. No protests were filed. Therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

## OPINION AND FINDINGS

Applicant received authority to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate interexchange intraLATA and interLATA telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska, under the name Century Telecommunications, Inc. from this Commission on October 16, 1995, pursuant to Application No. C-1229. No formal or departmental complaints are pending against applicant.

Applicant requests authority to change its corporate name to CenturyTel Telecommunications, Inc. A revised tariff has been submitted to the Commission to reflect the change in the company's name. There will be no change in the ownership or corporate structure of the company. Customers will be billed under the name of CenturyTel Telecommunications, Inc. The applicant provides alternative operator services and will brand all call requests under the CenturyTel Telecommunications name. Since the applicant does not provide service to any presubscribed customer base, no direct customer notification is required. Applicant, incorporated under the laws of the state of Texas, has obtained authority from the Nebraska Secretary of State to change its corporate name to CenturyTel Telecommunications, Inc. in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the application should be granted.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-1917 be, and it is hereby, granted and Century Telecommunications, Inc., Monroe, Louisiana, is hereby
