BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 12, 1998, Richard Alexander of Ayr, Nebraska, filed an application to revise the exchange area boundary of the Blue Hill exchange of the Glenwood Telephone Membership Corporation (Glenwood) to receive services from the Hastings exchange of Aliant Communications Company (Aliant). Notice of the application was published in the The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on November 13, 1998, pursuant to the Commission's Rules. Glenwood Telephone Membership Corporation filed a formal protest in this matter, therefore, a hearing was held on January 20, 1999.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Based upon testimony obtained at the hearing, there are three households in close proximity to the Applicant's residence that are currently being served by Aliant. Despite having Aliant service, these households are physically within the Blue Hill exchange. Exchange boundaries should reflect actual service area, and should avoid any unnecessary duplication of facilities. Therefore, in considering Mr. Alexander's application, the Commission should also assess whether any change in exchange boundaries should include these other households. Commission staff has prepared a proposed revised boundary that is attached as exhibit A, and is made a part of this order.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that its scope of review of Application No. C-1938 is hereby expanded to include consideration of modifying the boundaries of the Blue Hill and Hastings exchanges to reflect actual service areas, and to avoid unnecessary duplication of facilities as reflected in Staff Proposal Exhibit A (attached).
