On January 13, 1999, pursuant to Application No. C-1957, FirstWorld Communications, Inc. (FirstWorld) of San Diego, California, was granted authority to operate as a resale carrier of intrastate intraLATA and interLATA telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska.

By letter dated June 6, 2001, FirstWorld has requested that its certificate be canceled as of May 31, 2001. FirstWorld has not provided any toll services within the state of Nebraska since it was granted authority; therefore, no customers would be impacted by the withdrawal.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the certificate of operating authority previously issued in Application No. C-1957 to FirstWorld Communications, be, and it is hereby, canceled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order shall become effective on June 19, 2001.
