## BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 31, 1998, an application was filed by NXLD Company (Applicant) of Wilmington, Delaware, seeking authority to do business as Nextel Long Distance in Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on January 4, 1999. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

## OPINION AND FINDINGS

Applicant received authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services from this Commission on May 27, 1998, pursuant to Application No. C-1792. No formal or departmental complaints are pending against applicant.

Applicant requests authority to use the trade name Nextel Long Distance in Nebraska. Customers of the company were notified of this change by first-class, prepaid U.S. mail. The company's managerial, technical, and financial capabilities will not change. Applicant's initial tariff was filed under NXLD Company, dba Nextel Long Distance, the company's new trade name. Applicant has obtained authority from the Nebraska Secretary of State to utilize the trade name Nextel Long Distance in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the application should be granted.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-1967 be, and it is hereby, granted and NXLD Company is hereby authorized to use the trade name Nextel Long Distance in Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within thirty days from the date of this order.
