## BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 11, 1999, an application was filed by Cable & Wireless, Inc. (Applicant) of Vienna, Virginia, seeking authority to change its name to Cable & Wireless USA, Inc. Notice of the application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on January 12, 1999. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

## OPINION AND FINDINGS

Applicant received authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services from this Commission on March 5, 1991, pursuant to Application No. C-867. No formal or departmental complaints are pending against applicant.

Applicant requests authority to change its corporate name in Nebraska to Cable & Wireless USA, Inc. The proposed name change will not noticeably impact customers in Nebraska and will not affect the company's rates or service products. Applicant has obtained authority from the Nebraska Secretary of State to change its corporate name to Cable & Wireless USA, Inc.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the application should be granted.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-1973 be, and it is hereby, granted and Cable & Wireless, Inc. is hereby authorized to change its corporate name to Cable & Wireless USA, Inc. in Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within thirty days from the date of this order.
