BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 19, 1999, an application was filed by CapRock Communications Corp. (Applicant) of Dallas, Texas, seeking authority to change its name to CapRock Telecommunications Corp. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on January 20, 1999. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Applicant received authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services from this Commission on February 13, 1996, pursuant to Application No. C-1252. No formal or departmental complaints are pending against applicant.

Applicant requests authority to change its corporate name in Nebraska to CapRock Telecommunications Corp. The proposed name change will not noticeably impact customers in Nebraska and will not affect the company's management, ownership, quality of service, or rates. Applicant has obtained authority from the Nebraska Secretary of State to change its corporate name to CapRock Telecommunications Corp.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-1978 be, and it is hereby, granted and CapRock Communications Corp. is hereby authorized to change its corporate name to CapRock Telecommunications Corp. in Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within thirty days from the date of this order.


