## BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 9, 1999, Hamilton Telecommunications, (Hamilton) of Aurora, Nebraska, filed an application to revise the boundary of the Stockham exchange. Specifically, Hamilton requests a boundary change be made so as to allow Robert Shepard (Customer) to receive service from Hamilton. Customer currently subscribes to Aliant Communications Company (Aliant) in the Sutton exchange. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record on March 17, 1999, pursuant to Commission Rules. By letter dated April 26, 1999, Aliant consented to the proposed change in boundaries between the Stockham and Sutton exchanges.

## OPINION AND FINDINGS

Hamilton and Aliant are local exchange carriers operating in Nebraska. This application is governed by Neb. Rev. Stat. secs. 75-612 and 75-613 (Reissue 1996). These statutes provide that if the telephone companies affected by the proposed boundary revisions do not object to the application, the application may be processed by modified procedure. In this case, no protests were filed. Therefore, this application has been administered pursuant to the Commission's modified procedure rule.

A map marked "Exhibit A," showing the proposed revision of the Stockham and Sutton boundaries, is attached hereto, and made a part of this order. Aliant has received consideration for the proposed change, has consented to the revision of the exchange boundary, and has expressed its willingness to relinquish said area to permit Hamilton to furnish service to Customer.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the statutory requirements have been met.
