## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On April 5, 1999, Cable USA, Inc. (Cable USA) filed an application seeking approval of an application seeking approval of its voluntarily negotiated interconnection agreement with GTE Midwest Incorporated (GTE). Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record on April 7, 1999, pursuant to the Commission rules. No protests were filed; therefore, this application will be processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure. Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Cable USA and GTE entered into an interconnection agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations. After reviewing the interconnection agreement, the Commission finds and concludes that neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity. Section 252(e) of the Act mandates this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the interconnection agreement filed April 5, 1999, should be approved.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the voluntarily-negotiated interconnection agreement between Cable USA and GTE be, and is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an electronic copy of the final interconnection agreement be filed on or before May 24, 1999.
