BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed April 21, 1999, RDST, Inc. (Applicant) of Irving, Texas, seeks authority to operate as a resale common carrier of telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 26, 1999. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Applicant is a corporation organized under the laws of Texas and is authorized to transact business within the state of Nebraska. Applicant initially will offer prepaid calling cards to residents throughout the state of Nebraska and will later expand its offerings to include switched and dedicated "1+" long distance telecommunications services. Applicant does not own equipment or facilities used to provide telecommunications services; therefore, applicant will utilize the facilities of Sprint, AT&T, MCI, or other certificated underlying carriers. Applicant filed evidence demonstrating its financial, technical and managerial competency.

Interexchange reseller applications are subject to Commission jurisdiction under Neb. Rev. Stat. secs. 75-604 and 86-805 and Title 291 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5, Rule 003.12. From examination of the application filed herein, the Commission finds applicant has provided all the information required by the Commission, possesses adequate financial resources to provide the proposed service, and possesses adequate technical and managerial competency to provide the proposed service. The application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2037 be, and it is hereby, granted and RDST, Inc. of Irving, Texas, is certified as a resale common carrier of telecommunications services in the state of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant shall file, in accordance with the applicable statutes on or before April 30th of each year, an annual report with this Commission consisting of (a) a copy of any report filed with the Federal Communications Commission, (b) a copy of any annual report to stockholders and (c) a copy of the latest Form 10-K filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission. If these are not available, applicant shall submit a balance sheet and income statement for the previous year of operation, as well as the investment made in telephone plant and equipment located within the state, accumulated depreciation thereon, operating revenues and expenses, and taxes.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file its current tariff prior to offering service pursuant to the certificate granted in this order.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby made, the Commission's official certificate of authority to furnish the service authorized herein as a common carrier.


