BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed January 28, 2000, Cable & Wireless Global Markets, Inc. (Cable) of Washington, D.C., seeks authority to voluntarily withdraw its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 1, 2000. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

Cable was authorized by this Commission to operate as a reseller of interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska on June 15, 1999, pursuant to Application No. C-2039.

Cable currently wishes to discontinue service in Nebraska and, therefore, requests that its certificate to provide such service be withdrawn. Cable does not have customers in Nebraska at this time. Cable has no pending departmental, formal or informal complaints with the Commission.

Upon consideration of the request, and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Cable may withdraw the certificate previously issued to it in Application No. C-2039.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2039 be, and it is hereby, granted and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity of Cable & Wireless Global Markets, Inc. is withdrawn.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Cable & Wireless Global Markets, Inc. no longer provide intrastate interexchange intraLATA and interLATA service in Nebraska.



